Remember that the deadline for applying to participate in the Inaugural APT Conference is approaching. The conference will be held October 17-19, 2003, at Calvin College's Prince Conference Center in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

The deadline to apply to participate is February 15, 2003. Proposals submitted by that deadline will receive first consideration. Proposals submitted later will be considered if spaces for additional papers remain. Apply right away if you want to be sure of receiving first consideration!

The Conference Committee welcomes submissions on all topics in and from all approaches to political theory, political philosophy, and the history of political thought. If you are interested in serving as a panel chair or commentator, be sure to apply, too.

However, over the past few months, the referring link has failed on occasion, probably because of incomplete upgrades of the underlying Microsoft server software. Similar passing problems have affected portions of the site, especially the more complex Membership and Conference Participation submission pages. In all cases, the problems were minor ones that were corrected quickly.
